RIP Floyd you will be missed by us and your CPE/AKC Agility Friends. Ron's little brown dog.

Floyd was always a very loving gentle sheltie. He was more of a CPE agility dog than an AKC agility dog. He was very quite and loveable. Meal meal time brought him to life quickly and he would naturally spin left with the thought of a meal coming his way and peel rubber back to his crate and stamp his feet back and forth where he was fed while he waited for his food to be served. He also had a ritual with Ron before an agility run where they would see who could jump straight up the highest.

Floyd was a rescue dog that we got from the Houston Sheltie Sanctuary where his foster family Frank and Jennie Potti realized early that he would make a great agility dog. Floyd was owner relinquished from a breeder where he was kept outside in pens with 16 other shelties. He and one other dog were heartwarm negative in that group of shelties.

Floyd loved his dad and would only run for him. If someone else tried to run him, he would act like he didn't know what agility was.

His love for agility brought him 1000 PLT, 3 C-ATCH'S and one C-ATE in CPE participated in 3 CPE trials, 2016, 2017 and 2019. In AKC he made it to masters in JWW and Standard and Excellent in FAST.

In 2021 his agility career ended when he had a pre-pubic tendon tear that was inoperative. He then took up Rally and received his Novice Rally title. He also received his Canine Good Citizenship and Trick Dog Titles.

We lost Floyd to Orothelial Carcenoma (UC) also known as Transitional Cell Carinoma (TCC) which is very common to shelties. We are very happy he was a major part of our lives.

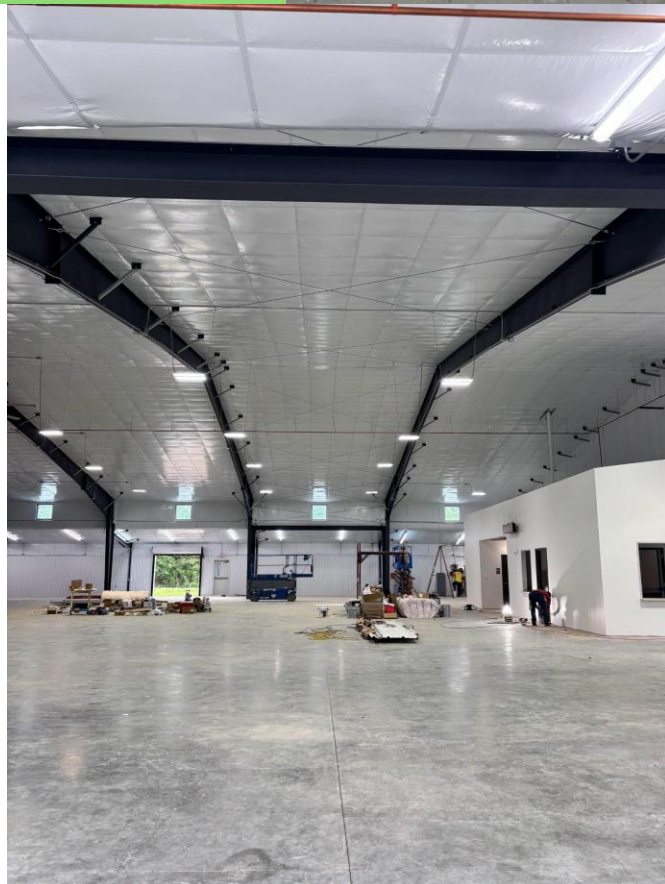
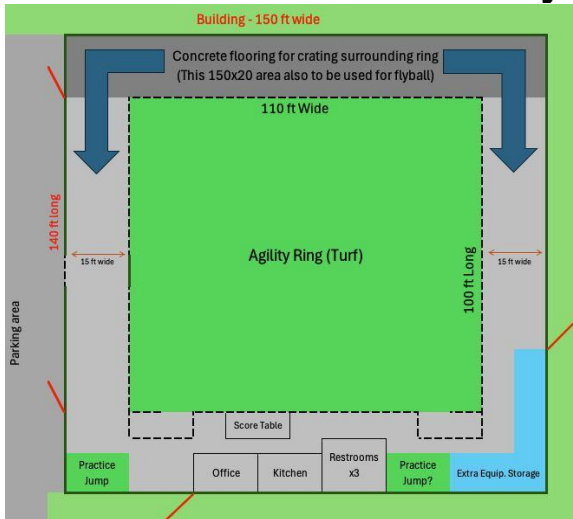

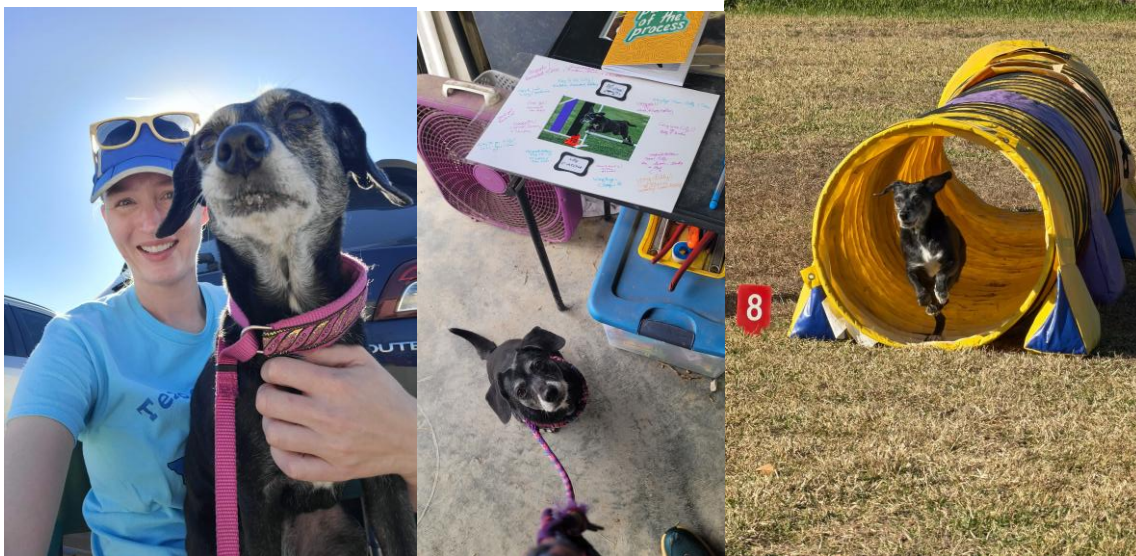
